



WHY ISLAMIC MANAGEMENT?

- A process to bring Islam as the complete way of life,
- Strengthening the process of knowledge seeking among people especially the Muslim,
- Establish a people's thinking framework that rooted to the right teaching of Islam,
- □ Free human thought from the ideas and theories that are not suited with Islamic principles,
- Conventional approach has many drawbacks and weaknesses
 - Separating management from religious life
 - Too focus on physical and material aspects
 - The emphasis on the concept of "the end justifies the means"



WHY ISLAMIC MANAGEMENT?

- Weaknesses of Conventional Management
 - Separating management from religious life
 - Too focus on physical and material aspects
 - The emphasis on the concept of "the end justifies the means"
 - Man is only a tool and can be manipulated for the sake of profit and worldly purposes
 - Reliance on reasons alone (thinking) and deny the importance of religious guidance
 - Human strength is always seen not from God's will who created man



ISLAMIC MANAGEMENT CONCEPT

- The concept of Islamic Management is closely related to three main problems that underlie the overall management:
 - human affairs
 - practice
 - organization
 - Human must be seen as the perfect creation, not as tool.
 - 2. Human was created to carry dual duties as the worshipers and the caretaker (caliph)
 - 3. Whatever man do, it cannot go beyond worshipers limit.

Refering to the al-Qur'an (revelation) as main source Consultation & meeting before decision is made Maintaining economic activities for public interest.



All the 5 Functions of Shariah Management are known as :


- 1. Shariah Thinking





Source of Management Function and Manager's Role

Islamic perspective of leadership traits are clearly mentioned in the Holy Book, Surah An-Naml (21). It also portrays the functions and roles of managers:





الْحَمْدُ لِلّهِ الَّذِي فَضَلَّانَا عَلَى كَثِيرٍ مِنْ عِبَادِهِ الْمُؤْمِنِينَ وَلَقَدْ آتَيْنَا دَاوُودَ وَسُلَيْمَانَ عِلْمًا وَقَالاً

We gave (in the past) knowledge to David and Solomon: And they both said: "Praise be to God, Who has favored us above many of his servants who believe!"

☐ Allah says in the holy Quran surah Al Asr verse 1-3:

By the token of time. Verily, man is in loss. Except those who believe and do righteous good deeds and recommend one another to the truth, patience and constancy.

Conventional Management

- The lesson and message from this verse highlighted the importance of time management and that we should internalize it as part of daily lives.
- ☐ Time is one of the gift or nikmat given by Allah s.w.t. to us. Those who manage time well are those who will reap success while those who mismanage their time are those who will be the losers and shall live to regret it. From here, we can see how the importance of time management in the eyes of Islam.

The Prophet (pbuh) said:

"Take benefit of five before five: Your youth before your old age, your health before your sickness, your wealth before your poverty, your free time before you are preoccupied, and your life before your death" (Narrated by Ibn Abbas and reported by Al Hakim)
